

Clinical Medical Assistant Training Program

Hanford Adult School in Partnership with Boston Reed College

Program Summary: As a Clinical Medical Assistant the student will be trained to help the physician carry out procedures, care for patients, perform basic lab tests and administer medications. The Clinical Medical Assistant works in a physician's office or a clinic setting. This course combines classroom instruction of 134 hours and off-site externship of 160 hours to provide students with a comprehensive learning experience.

Course Fee: \$2995.00 includes books, consumable supplies, externship, and course completion certificate.

Pay Schedule: \$250 deposit to hold your seat in the class, \$1375 of the course fee due 1st night of class, \$1370 balance due 10th week of class.

Community Job Survey: Starting pay \$15 – 22 per hour.

Certification: This program satisfies all training guidelines established by the California Certifying Board for Medical Assistants (CCBMA) and graduates will be qualified to apply for optional certification.

Schedule: Classes will be held on Monday & Thursday evenings from 6:00 pm to 9:30 pm. Class begins on January 23, 2012.

Pre-requisites: Minimum 18 years of age and high school completion or its equivalent. Students need competency in, or completion of a basic computer operations course. Students will be required to have access to the Internet, printing capabilities and an email address. Prior to placement in an externship, students will need to show proof of completion of CPR for the Healthcare Provider course, a health examination including TB testing and submission of a resume. Students must also have a basic mastery of English reading and comprehension and Math basics.
